**A BILL**

To require Federal law enforcement officers, including contract employees, and members of the armed forces engaged in crowd control, riot control, or arrest or detainment of individuals engaged in civil disobedience, demonstrations, protests, or riots to visibly display identifying information.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Law Enforcement  
5 Identification Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. IDENTIFYING INFORMATION FOR FEDERAL LAW EN-**  
2 **FORCEMENT OFFICERS, INCLUDING CON-**  
3 **TRACT EMPLOYEES, AND MEMBERS OF THE**  
4 **ARMED FORCES ENGAGED IN CROWD CON-**  
5 **TROL, RIOT CONTROL, OR ARREST OR DE-**  
6 **TAINMENT.**

7 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

8 (1) the term “Federal law enforcement officer”  
9 means—

10 (A) an employee or officer in a position in  
11 the executive, legislative, or judicial branch of  
12 the Federal Government who is authorized by  
13 law to engage in or supervise a law enforcement  
14 function; or

15 (B) an employee or officer of a contractor  
16 or subcontractor (at any tier) of an agency in  
17 the executive, legislative, or judicial branch of  
18 the Federal Government who is authorized by  
19 law or under the contract with the agency to  
20 engage in or supervise a law enforcement func-  
21 tion;

22 (2) the term “law enforcement function” means  
23 the prevention, detection, or investigation of, or the  
24 prosecution or incarceration of any person for, any  
25 violation of law; and

1           (3) the term “member of an armed force”  
2           means a member of any of the armed forces, as de-  
3           fined in section 101(a)(4) of title 10, United States  
4           Code, or a member of the National Guard, as de-  
5           fined in section 101(3) of title 32, United States  
6           Code.

7           (b) REQUIREMENT.—Each Federal law enforcement  
8           officer or member of an armed force who is engaged in  
9           any form of crowd control, riot control, or arrest or detain-  
10          ment of individuals engaged in an act of civil disobedience,  
11          demonstration, protest, or riot in the United States shall  
12          at all times display identifying information in a clearly  
13          visible fashion, which shall include the Federal agency,  
14          last name, and badge number of the Federal law enforce-  
15          ment officer or the armed force, last name, and rank of  
16          the member of an armed force, respectively.
