**A BILL**

To authorize the extension of nondiscriminatory treatment (normal trade relations treatment) to the products of Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, and Tajikistan.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF APPLICATION OF TITLE IV**  
4                   **OF THE TRADE ACT OF 1974 TO THE PROD-**  
5                   **UCTS OF KAZAKHSTAN, UZBEKISTAN, AND**  
6                   **TAJIKISTAN.**

7       (a) **PRESIDENTIAL DETERMINATIONS AND EXTEN-**  
8 **SIONS OF NONDISCRIMINATORY TREATMENT.**—Notwith-

1 standing any provision of title IV of the Trade Act of 1974  
2 (19 U.S.C. 2431 et seq.), the President may—

3 (1) determine that such title should no longer  
4 apply to Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, or Tajikistan; and

5 (2) after making a determination under para-  
6 graph (1) with respect to Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan,  
7 or Tajikistan, proclaim the extension of nondiscrim-  
8 inatory treatment (normal trade relations treatment)  
9 to the products of that country.

10 (b) TERMINATION OF APPLICATION OF TITLE IV.—

11 On and after the date on which the President proclaims  
12 the extension of nondiscriminatory treatment to the prod-  
13 ucts of Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, or Tajikistan, title IV of  
14 the Trade Act of 1974 shall cease to apply to the country  
15 to which such extension pertains.
